Your Guide to Getting Rid of Your Leaves

BAG'EM

for pick up on your trash day picked up weekly on trash day, no limits **RAKE 'EM**

for Supplemental Loose Leaf Collection collected 1 or 2 times, weather permitting

What Is Supplemental Loose Leaf Collection?

<u>IT IS</u>: an extra service provided by the Public Works Department that helps remove leaves from neighborhoods (weather permitting).

IT IS NOT: a weekly scheduled pickup. If you want or need that, you are encouraged to bag your leaves and set them out with your trash.

YOU CAN EXPECT: your leaves to be collected 1 or 2 times during the season. Leaf volume and weather conditions affect how long it takes crews to get through an area.

How Does it Work?

Rake your leaves to the edge of the street, never into alleyways. Crews make their way through an area, collecting leaves.

When Is Leaf Season?

Supplemental Leaf Collection starts 11/03/2025 (weather permitting). Leaf collection pauses for winter weather so crews can swap out leaf boxes for snow removal equipment. If winter weather is prolonged, collection will end so crews can focus on snow and ice removal.
